

OVERVIEW

Embark on a thrilling 10-day adventure from Delhi to Jibhi/Manali, exploring the majestic landscapes of Himachal Pradesh and Spiti Valley. Begin with a scenic drive to Jibhi, then traverse the exhilarating Jalori Pass to reach Chhitkul. Marvel at the serene beauty of Kalpa and its spiritual sites before journeying through the confluences and peaks to Tabo. Discover ancient monasteries and remote valleys en route to Mudh, then explore the heart of Spiti in Kaza. Witness the high villages and fossils, cross the dramatic Chicham Bridge, and experience the magical Moon Lake at Chandratal. Conclude with a return to Manali and Delhi.

- ➤ Backpackers: Grab a Volvo bus or shared taxi from Delhi to Jibhi. Buckle up for a 12-14 hour ride through winding roads and stunning scenery.
- ➤ Bikers: Hop on a Volvo bus from Delhi to Manali. Once you hit Manali, pick up your bikes and rev up for an epic 150 km ride to Jibhi.
- Overnight: Crash in Jibhi, a serene hamlet nestled in the Tirthan Valley, surrounded by lush green forests and rivers.







Day 2: Jibhi to Chhitkul via Jalori Pass - High Mountain Pass Thrills

- ➢ Rise and shine early! Tackle the thrilling hairpin bends of Jalori Pass, soaking in the jaw-dropping views. Snap some epic photos at Kinnaur Gate before cruising on to Chhitkul, the last inhabited village near the Indo-Tibetan border.
- Overnight: Unwind in Chhitkul, a picturesque village offering breathtaking mountain views and crisp, clean air.







Day 3: Chhitkul to Kalpa - Scenic Bliss and Spiritual Sites

- ➤ After breakfast, hit the road from Chhitkul to Kalpa. En route, make a daring stop at Suicide Point for some heart-stopping views and photos. In Kalpa, explore the serene Kalpa Monastery, nestled in the shadow of the majestic Kinner Kailash range.
- Overnight: Settle in Kalpa, a charming town famous for its apple orchards and panoramic views of snowcapped peaks.







Day 4: Kalpa to Tabo via Khab Sangam and Nako Hills - Confluences and Peaks

➤ Depart from Kalpa early and head towards Tabo. Make a pit stop at Khab Sangam, where the Spiti and Sutlej rivers meet in a dramatic confluence. Continue through the stunning Nako Hills, with mesmerizing views of Mount Reo Purgyil, the highest peak in Himachal Pradesh.

Overnight: Arrive in Tabo by evening and settle down for the night.





Day 5: Explore Tabo and Journey to Mudh - Ancient Monasteries and Remote Valleys

- ➤ Start your day exploring Tabo Monastery, often dubbed the 'Ajanta of the Himalayas' for its ancient murals and sculptures. Check out the Tabo Caves before hitting the road to Mudh, the last village in the beautiful Pin Valley. En route, stop at the spectacular Dhankar Monastery and cross the Tailing Bridge.
- Overnight: Sleep under the stars in Mudh, surrounded by rugged beauty and tranquility





Day 6: Mudh to Kaza - The Heart of Spiti

- Leave Mudh in the morning and ride to Kaza, the heart of Spiti. Visit the iconic Key Monastery, perched on a hilltop with panoramic views of the valley. Explore the vibrant town of Kaza and its bustling markets.
- Overnight: Rest up in Kaza, your base for exploring the Spiti Valley.







- ➤ Kick off your day with a visit to Langza village, famous for fossil hunting and a massive Buddha statue overlooking the valley. Next, head to Komik, the highest village in Asia accessible by a motorable road. Finally, visit Hikkim, home to the world's highest post office where you can send a postcard from the top of the world.
- > Overnight: Another night in Kaza, soaking in the high-altitude vibes.







Day 8: Kaza to Chandratal via Chicham Bridge and Kunzum La - Moon Lake Magic

- Depart Kaza in the morning and cross the Chicham Bridge, the highest bridge in Asia. Continue your journey through the high mountain pass of Kunzum La. Arrive at the ethereal Chandratal, also known as the Moon Lake, for some of the most stunning scenery you'll ever witness.
- Overnight: Camp out under the starlit sky by the shores of Chandratal.







- ➤ Pack up early and start the journey from
 Chandratal back to Manali. Arrive in Manali by
 afternoon, and catch your Volvo bus for the
 evening ride back to Delhi.
- Overnight: Overnight journey to Delhi on the bus.







Day 10: Arrival in Delhi - Home Sweet Home

> Arrive in Delhi in the morning, with a heart full of memories and a camera packed with epic shots from your Spiti Valley adventure

- Ex-Delhi Volvo Transfers: Comfortable Volvo bus transfers from Delhi.
- Surface Transfers: Tempo Traveller for backpackers.
- Himalayan Bike: Bike provided from Manali to Manali for bikers.
- > 7 Nights/8 Days: Double and triple sharing basis accommodations.
- Breakfast and Dinner: Starting from dinner on day 2 to breakfast on day 9.
- Expert Guidance: Road captain and trip captain throughout the journey.
- Support Team: Backup vehicle and mechanic support for a hassle-free trip.
- Included: Bike fuel for the duration of the ride from Manali to Manali.
- > All Inclusive: Inner line permits, tolls, and taxes covered.



Exclusions

- ➤ GST (5%) is applicable extra.
- Any kind of food or beverage that is not included in the package like alcoholic drinks, mineral water, meals/refreshments/lunches on the highway.
- Any personal expenses like a tip to the drivers, entry to
 - monuments/monasteries, camera/video camera charges, camel safari, river rafting, laundry, telephone bills, tips, etc
- ➤ Any cost arising due to natural calamities like landslides, roadblocks etc. (to be borne directly by the customer on the spot)
- Anything not mentioned in the inclusions.

Important things to carry:

- ➤ A genuine Government ID Card is required.
- Adequate and warm clothing, including woolen socks, a cap, fleece jackets or warmers, a down jacket, and toiletries, is recommended.
- Essential items such as sunscreen, lip balm, and high-quality UV protection sunglasses are advisable.

Cancellation Policies:

The initial advance booking amount is non-refundable for any cancellations. However,

- Cancellation fees equivalent to 50% of the trip cost will be applied if cancellations are made 30 days before the trip's start date.
- > Cancellation fees amounting to 75% of the trip cost will be imposed for cancellations made 15-30 days before the scheduled start date of the trip.
- Cancellation fees totaling 100% of the trip cost will be levied for cancellations made within 0-15 days before the trip's scheduled start date.
