Day 3: Nubra Valley Voyage | Conquering Khardung-la


- Gear up for an exhilarating drive as you journey from Leh to Nubra Valley via the legendary Khardung-la Pass, one of the highest motorable roads in the world.

- ✓ All inner line permits.

- Basic medical equipment with oxygen cylinders.
- Helmets, elbow pads, knee pads and gloves for bikers.

Exclusions

- GST (5%) is applicable extra.
- Any kind of food or beverage that is not included in the package like alcoholic drinks, mineral water, meals/refreshments/lunches on the highway.
- Any personal expenses like a tip to the drivers, entry to monuments/monasteries, camera/video camera charges, camel safari, river rafting, laundry, telephone bills, tips, etc
- Any cost arising due to natural calamities like landslides, roadblocks etc. (to be borne directly by the customer on the spot)
- Anything not mentioned in the inclusions.

Important things to carry:

- Genuine Government ID Card
- Cozy and warm clothing such as woolen socks, a cap, fleece jackets or warmers, a down jacket, and toiletries.
- > Sunscreen and lip balm, along with high-quality UV protection sunglasses.
- > Personal medications, if required, and a few medicines specifically for altitude sickness (essential).
- > Power banks are necessary as there is no electricity at some remote places.
- Keep in mind that only post-paid numbers will function in Leh City, and beyond that, most areas are devoid of network coverage.

- ₹10,000/- needs to be submitted as security for the bike before the start of the trip. Any damage to the bike, except engine damage, has to be borne directly by the client.
- ₹2000/- per person extra on double sharing for the whole trip.

Cancellation Policies:

The initial advance booking amount is non-refundable for any cancellations. However,
