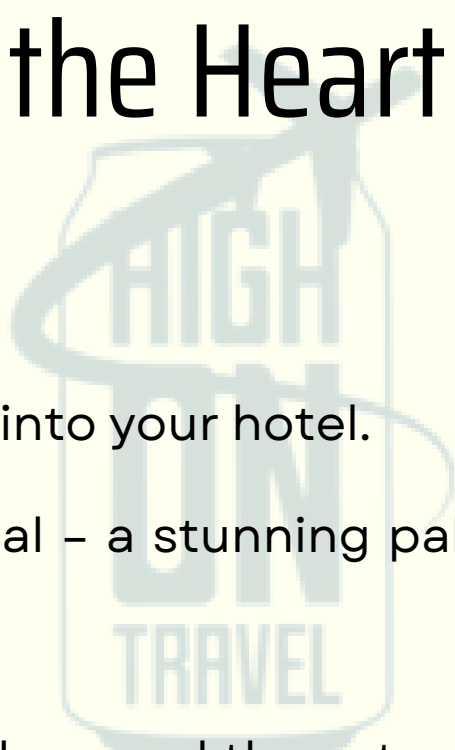
OVERVIEW

Day 2: Forts, Views & Flavors of Jaipur

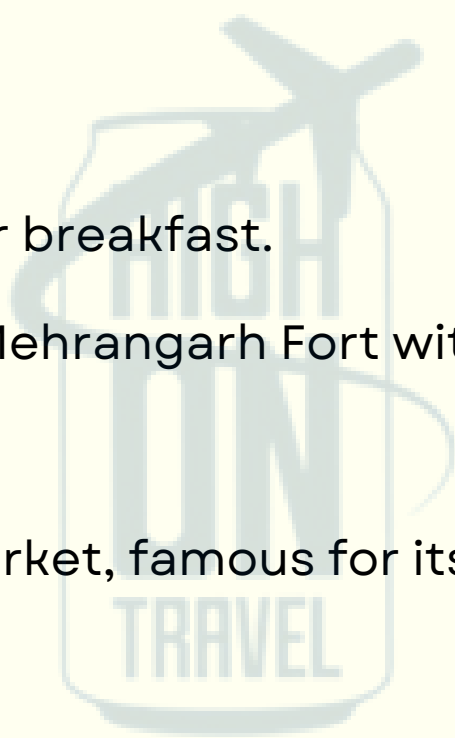
- Kick off with a visit to the majestic Amer Fort for stunning palace views.

Day 3: Journey to the Blue City – Jodhpur

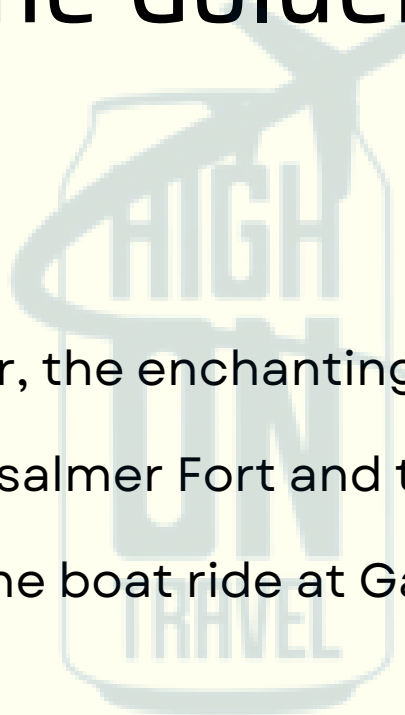
- Depart for Jodhpur after breakfast.
